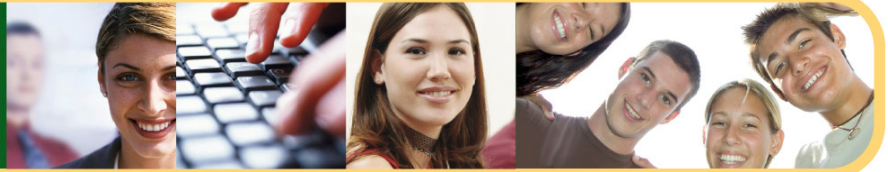

The Challenge:

Alan preferred sports to academic studies, and was introduced to a vocational qualification in Coaching when running Kirkcudbright Academy's football teams. Alan met Minerva People when the Academy linked with us to introduce NVQ Level 2 in Team Leading for those pupils responsible for managing projects. He didn't really know what he wanted to do after leaving school.

The Solution:

On leaving school, Alan firstly sourced his own part-time employment at Galloway Country Style in Gatehouse of Fleet and, as he enjoyed helping people, he came back to Minerva to see if he could gain another vocational qualification. In December 2008 Alan started an NVQ Level 3 in Customer Service through a Modern Apprenticeship programme. As the shop, post office and café were so busy, it was easy to capture evidence and Alan achieved the qualification in record time.

Still unsure of his long-term future career, Alan participated in a Summer School run by the University for West of Scotland, gaining knowledge in marketing, research skills and entrepreneurship, as a pre-cursor for University. He considered setting up a business, but decided that he needed more age and experience under his belt, so this idea was put to one side for future consideration.

Alan discovered an interest in Investment Banking, and approached local stockbrokers and accountancy firms, where he successfully gained employment locally. The flexibility and style of learning of Pitman Training courses appealed, so Alan signed up for a Diploma in Accounting and Finance, also taking advantage of Individual Learning Account funding to reduce costs.
